

## 3 escape from burning home in Lake Stevens

LAKE STEVENS, Wash. - An adult and two kids escaped from a home in flames Sunday.

The 3-bedroom house is in the 9200 block of 19th Place Southeast.

Firefighters say the blaze started in a bedroom. Crews responded to the home after receiving reports of a mattress on fire just after 10 a.m., David Petersen with the Lake Stevens Fire Department says.

Firefighters arrived to find heavy smoke seeping out from all sides of the home.

Peterson says the homeowner tried to extinguish the blaze and then got out.

The extent of the damage to the home was not immediately clear.

The Snohomish County Fire Marshal's office and the Lake Stevens Fire Marshal will work to determine the cause of the fire.
