STAGE 1 BURN BAN CALLED FOR SNOHOMISH COUNTY

Lake Stevens, Snohomish County – Effective December 12, 2017 at 2:00 pm due to the stagnant weather, the Puget Sound Clean Air Agency is calling for a Stage 1 Burn Ban in Snohomish County. High Pressure systems continue to keep the air stagnant in our area which elevates the levels of air pollution in the region. Until the fronts change, the burn ban is in effect until further notice.

These burn ban restrictions apply to all citizens residing within the Lake Stevens Fire District boundaries including the City of Lake Stevens and the Urban Growth Area.

All outdoor burn permits, including permits issued by PSCAA (Puget Sound Clean Air Agency) for agricultural burning, are suspended until this ban is lifted.
